ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

Sealed bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, skills, equipment, and miscellaneous items necessary for the construction of the CITY OF WHITE STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT located in Bartow County, Georgia will be received by the CITY OF WHITE, herein referred to as the **OWNER**, 29 WEST ROCKY STREET PO BOX 116, WHITE, GA 30184 until:

Monday, November 30, 2020, 10:00 A.M., Local Time

Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time in the Council Chambers. Bids received after said time and date will not be considered by Owner and will be returned unopened.

The approximate extent and character of the Work is generally described as follows:

The City of White Stormwater Improvements Project in the City of White, Georgia includes: the removal of 2 existing 15" clay pipes, three existing trees, and the removal and replacement of approximately 125 LF of hog wire fence. The project also includes the installation of: 54 LF of 24" steel casing pipe and 58 LF of 48" steel casing pipe using jack and bore methods, four concrete headwalls and all related work such as erosion control measures, materials, labor, and appurtenances for completing the work as indicated on the construction drawings dated 10-16-2020.

Bidders shall inform themselves concerning Georgia Laws and comply with same. **NOTE:** The Contractors Affidavit for Electronic Verification of Work Authorization Programs form (E-Verify) shall be executed and submitted as part of the bid package. Contractor's Bid will be considered non-responsive without conformance to E-Verify requirements.

Bidding Documents are available for review and purchase by prospective Bidders. Bidding Documents may be obtained for a non-refundable fee of \$100.00, payable by check or money order at the offices of the Engineer, **Rindt-McDuff Associates, Inc., 334 Cherokee Street, Marietta, Georgia, 30060, 770-427-8123**. The check or money order shall be made payable to Rindt-McDuff Associates, Inc. The Owner is not obligated to consider a Bidder's proposal, if Bidder is not on record with the Issuing Office as having received complete Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office.

The time allowed for Substantial Completion from the date of Notice to Proceed is 60 consecutive calendar days. The project has a maximum time for total completion which shall not exceed 90 consecutive calendar days from the starting date specified in the Notice to Proceed.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond with good and sufficient surety or sureties approved by the Owner for faithful acceptance of the contract, payable to, in favor of, and for the protection of the Owner in an amount equivalent to five percent (5%) of the total amount payable by the terms of the Contract or, in lieu thereof, in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or cash in equal amount.

The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds with the executed Agreement meeting the requirements of the Contract Documents and executed on the forms attached to the Agreement. The terms and time for payment are set forth in the Agreement.

Surety and insurance companies must be listed in the Federal Registry of Insurance Companies Circular 570, holding Certificates of Authority and Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds, be licensed by the Georgia Insurance Department and the Georgia Secretary of State to do business in the State of Georgia.

All Bids will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the day of the Bid Opening, but Owner may, in its sole discretion, release any Bid and return the Bid security prior to that date.

Each bid must be submitted in a SEALED ENVELOPE, addressed to the Owner. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be plainly marked on the outside as, "**City of White Stormwater Improvements Project**". If bid is forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the Bid must be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope to the attention of the Purchasing Manager at the address previously given.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive formalities, and to re-advertise.

MESSAGE: Addendum No. 3

1. A clarification to the bid form is attached. The modifications are on page 3 only and are intended to clarify the location of improvements. Item 2 has been revised to state the improvements on the eastern side of the existing railroad. Item 3 has been revised to state the improvements on the western side of the existing railroad.
2. Note that a CSXT Facility Encroachment Agreement (permit) has been obtained for this project.
3. The Item 5 allowance shown on page 3 of the Bid Form allows for 5 days of CSXT Flagmen coverage. If the contractor believes additional days for CSXT Flagmen will be required, the contractor is welcome to include this in Items 1, 2 and 3 per contractor preference.
4. Contractor will be responsible for scheduling all work with CSXT and CSXT Flagmen through the CSX Property Portal.
5. Note that this is a GEFA funded project and that the contractor is required to comply with GEFA funding requirements as shown in the specifications for this project.

ARTICLE 2 – BIDDER’S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

ARTICLE 3 – BIDDER’S REPRESENTATIONS

3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:

A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, and any data and reference items identified in the Bidding Documents, and hereby acknowledges receipt of the following Addenda:

B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

C. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests, if any, of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions, if any, relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.

- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.
- F. Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.
- J. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 4 – BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION

4.01 Bidder certifies that:

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 4.01.D:
 - 1. "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process;
 - 2. "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
 - 3. "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and

4. "coercive practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.
