City Council Meeting  
May 7, 2018

Present at the meeting were Mayor Kim Billue, Councilman Dennis Huskins, Councilman Tina Wilhite, City Clerk Robin Deal and City Attorney, Leslie Simmons.

The meeting was called to order by our Mayor Billue at 7:00 p.m. Councilman Huskins opened the meeting with an invocation.

The minutes from the meeting of April 2, 2018 were read and approved.

Mayor Billue stated the proposed Car Wash Ordinance was pushed to the next council meeting.

Mayor Billue gave an update on city hall and reviewed a possible bid for the work that needs to be done. Michael Parker Construction has submitted a bid. Councilman Dennis Huskins made a motion this be tabled till the next council meeting. Councilman Wilhite seconded and the vote carried.

Chief Hunter gave an update on the police department and announced a chaplain had been selected. Pastor Jerry Jude from Bread of Life Church will serve.

Jimmy Nichols reported on the progress of the water dept.

Mayor Billue discussed the need for the city to get a safety deposit box. Councilman Huskins made a motion and Councilman Wilhite seconded. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

Mayor Billue discussed the possibility of having a local Farmer's Market here at City Hall twice a week. Councilman Huskins made a motion and Councilman Wilhite seconded. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

Mayor Billue discussed the lack of members on the Planning and Zoning Committees. She asked for volunteers. No one stepped forward.

Mayor Billue discussed a request for annexation of property into the city belonging to Mike McConnville. The motion was made by Councilman Huskins and seconded by Councilman Wilhite. A vote was taken and the motion carried. Proper paperwork will need to be filed.

Mayor Billue discussed the possibility of the city purchasing 26 acres of land to be used for a multi-purpose building, senior center, park, nature trail, eco pond, and ballfields.

A public hearing/special meeting was planned for 6:30 p.m. on May 29<sup>th</sup>. Councilman Huskins made a motion and it was seconded by Councilman Wilhite. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

Councilman Huskins made the motion to end the meeting. Councilman Wilhite seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion carried. The meeting was closed at 7:45.
