

**Minutes for  
City of White City Council Meeting  
(Special Called)  
Monday, April 10, 2023**

- I. Call Meeting to Order: Mayor Curtis Powell called the meeting to order. Council Members Present: Stephanie Nicholson, Kim Billue, and Charles Buttrum.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation: Curtis led the Pledge of Allegiance and Stephanie led the Invocation.
- III. Approval of March Meeting Minutes: Minutes were not available for review and approval.
- IV. Vote on Mayor ProTem: Kim nominated Stephanie Nicholson for Mayor ProTem. There was no second for the nomination. Therefore, the issue was tabled at a later date.
- V. Vote on Signers for city banking accounts: There needs to be 3 signers for bank checks. There was a motion to add Curtis Powell and Stephanie Nicholson to all bank accounts. Kim Billue seconded the motion and there was a 3-0 vote in favor of the motion. The council authorized Kim Billue to make changes to bank accounts including adding new signatures. A resolution to this effect was approved.
- VI. Discuss special election for open council seat: Curtis asked Joseph Kirk to speak about the cost and timing of possible elections. There are three possible dates: June, September and November. Elections in June or September would cost approximately \$13, 200. The November election cost is already covered since we have other positions on the Ballot. Stephanie moved to accept Gary Crisp's resignation. Charles voted no. This issue was tabled.
- VII. Approval for Police Car repair: The Chief of Police stated that the insurance deductible is \$1,000 and the Council needs to approve that expenditure. Charles made the motion to approve and Stephanie seconded the motion. Kim voted not to approve. This issue was tabled.
- VIII. Appointment Replacement to serve on Planning and Zoning Commission (Added): Curtis informed the Council and citizens that he had appointed Danny Moore to replace him on the Planning and Zoning Commission. This appointment did not need to be approved by the City Council.
- IX. Executive Session to discuss personnel issues – Conducted.
- X. Motion to come back into regular session: Stephanie proposed hiring of Robin Cochran as the City Clerk. Kim made the motion and Stephanie seconded it. The vote was taken. Stephanie and Kim voted yes and Charles did not vote without a conflict of interest. So, the Motion passed.
- XI. Public Comments: Roger Oswald discussed several potential civil complaints that he would be forwarding to Mayor, Police Chief, and City Attorney. Tim Nicholson addressed Charles Buttrum about his not voting for Stephanie as Mayor ProTem.
