**RESOLUTION RE:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by virtue of the authority vested in the Mayor of the City of White, Georgia:


That the City may cancel the special election that was to be held on March 16, 2021, and swear Curtis “Kirk” Powell into office.
