

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE FOR THE PURPOSE OF **AMENDING THE FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT/FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE; SETTING FEES UNDER THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE AND THE FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT/FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE;** AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE HELD ON JUNE 1, 2020.

**WHEREAS**, the City of White has adopted a Stormwater Management Ordinance and a Floodplain Management/Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the administration of those ordinances and review of permit applications under those ordinances required detailed review by professional engineers, and whereas the City does not have professional engineers on staff and has to contract to provide such review, which is mandated by the Metropolitan North Georgia Water Planning District under the City's adopted ordinances as listed above; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4.7 of the Stormwater Management Ordinance authorizes the imposition of permit fees, where as the Floodplain Management/Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance does not specifically so authorize; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to amend the Floodplain Management/Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance to authorize fees and to set fees for said ordinance for that ordinance and the Stormwater Management Ordinance;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED, by virtue of the authority vested in the City Council by law, that the Floodplain Management/Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance is amended by adding Section 3.5, as follows:

3.5 The fee for review of any permit application or application for review of a floodplain management/flood damage prevention plan submitted under this Ordinance shall be set by the City Council by Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** AND IT HERE BY IS REVOLVED, that the fee schedule for the White Stormwater Management Ordinance shall be as follows:

\$1000 plus \$15 per acre over 10 acres; rereview of resubmittals shall cost 25% of the original amount.
