City Council Meeting

May 2nd, 2022

Present at the meeting were Mayor Pro Tem Gary Crisp, Council members Stephanie Nichols, Ryan Evans, City Attorney Leslie, and City clerk Twanda Hill. Not present Council member Charles Buttrum

The meeting was called to order. Council member Nicholson opened the meeting with an invocation. Council Member Gary Crisp lead the room in saying of the Pledge.

The Minutes from the April 5th, 2022, council meeting was approved. None opposing.

Twanda Hill gave city hall updates as following, reminded everyone to vote for a new mayor and city hall has water leak from the roof and need to be repaired.

Anthony gave Jimmy Nichols gave water report with 2 leaks for the month of April in whispering pines and 1 at Richards, and 2, 850, 000,000 gallons of water for the month of April. Repairs done on the clubhouse were done and the contractor done a great job. Anthony also explained the leak at city hall.

Chief Blake Davidson presented the police had several theft reports. the arrest for the theft of an ATV (side by side) that was stolen from the county. Mayor Pro Tem stated the council would address the Richards Road Project with Eddie and Terry. Mayor Pro Tem stated the project was not finished and Eddie stated he highlighted and read a few things from the contract that had not been completed by the contractor. Mayor Pro Tem Gary asked has the bill been paid and City Clerk Twanda Hill advised him, it had not been paid because she was advised by (him) Mayor Pro Tem Gary not pay the bill until the Richard Road Project had been completed. Council member Nichelson presented documents from Rentz McDuff stating the processing of the Richard Roads Projects to Eddie.

Terry Cornwell asked about his property and what was going to be done, Mayor Pro Gary stated we will have to look further into the matter.
