City Council Meeting
March 19th, 2026
Called Meeting

Present at the council meeting were Mayor Curtis Powell, Councilmembers Stephanie Nicholson, DJ Bennett, Karissa Noland, and Jean Swank, City Clerk Robin Cochran, and City Attorney Debra Golymbieski.

Mayor Powell called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m. and began with the pledge of allegiance. Councilmember Nicholson gave the invocation.

Mayor Powell started with a brief review of the IGA with Bartow County. He advised the finalization is underway and it should be ready for the April meeting. This IGA is for the transfer of the assets to of the Aubry Lift Station to the County and for them to pay off the USDA Sewer loan. There will also be a change in the service area in the final version.

Mayor Powell then made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss the property at 75 Richards Rd as well as Personnel issues. Councilmember Nicholson made the motion to go into Executive Session and Councilmember Bennett seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5-0 vote. The session started at 7:05 p.m.

The Mayor and Council returned to the meeting at 9:55 p.m. when the mayor asked for a motion to end the Executive Session. Councilmember Bennett made a motion to end the session and Councilmember Swank seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5-0 vote.

The Mayor reported that no votes were taken on the property, or the personnel issues. City Attorney, Debra Golymbieski advised the mayor that no vote was needed regarding the personnel issues.

Mayor Powell asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Swank made a motion to adjourn, and Councilmember Bennett seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5-0 vote. The meeting ended at 10:00 p.m.
